**Today's Gospel: John 14:21-27**

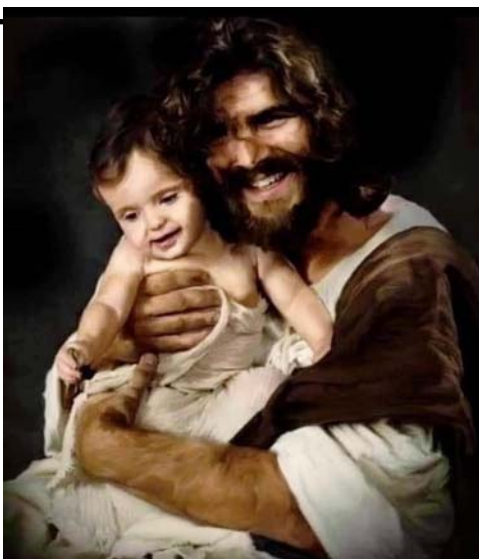
